As the new President of your Alumni Association, I want to thank everyone who contributes to our continued success: The Board members, volunteers and many PHS grads who pay dues and support us in other ways.

Especially, we give a big thank you to retiring President, Peggy Thompson Haxton '66 who worked tirelessly over the past several years.

In the past year, your Alumni Association has continued our mission of providing scholarships to qualified PHS graduating seniors toward **ANY TYPE** of continuing education be it tech school or college. With your help and support, a total of \$32,500 in scholarships was awarded to 21 PHS Seniors representing 26% of the graduating class. Congratulations to all the winners. Since our beginning in 1988, we have awarded \$433,750 to 356 PHS seniors.

We continued to raise scholarship funds and recognize PHS grads and former teachers at our annual Honor Roll Banquet where almost **\$8,000** was raised in sponsor fees, raffles and scholarship donations.

And a big thank you to every one of you, for supporting our mission, paying your membership dues, donating to our cause and attending our events. I doubt that there is any high school alumni association in Oklahoma or possibly the US, even for large high schools, that can even come close to what we do here in Perry, America!
